As many wise Christian scholars of former generations warned, when it comes to interpreting end-time prophecy, everyone is entitled to his opinion, but dogmatism is best avoided!

Failure to heed their advice has not only provoked many divisions and conflicts among believers over the years; it has also led many into grievous error and public shame!

However, the average Christian has no one to blame for being led astray by such people, but themselves. In most cases, the very content of their sermons is itself a clear indication their view on eschatology could be as equally twisted and full of factual error!

The following advice a certain "apostle" gave to his congregation and viewers on social media a week or two ago is a perfect example of what we are saying. It says:

The Prime Minister of Israel is burdened with the heavy responsibility that, if he makes just one error, he could lose the only ally he has, the United States... Hate has taken possession of the minds of Hamas and of all who have been influenced by the propaganda. They have lost their ability to reason and allowed themselves to be blinded by this mad hatred...

Don't open your hearts to hate, resist antisemitism, don't curse Israel, but be vigilant and try to have a clear vision of God's plan in these last days, for Israel and for the rest of the world. Redeem the time, try to save with the love that God has deposited in us.
