

The movement towards peace between Israel and her Arab neighbours has continued since the foundation of the Israeli State in 1948. But peace there has never been, only short periods without war!

Numerous books have been written on the subject, especially from among prominent Evangelical Christian leaders worldwide. But most of them say the same thing. They point out how the United Nations and various world leaders have all given the Middle East Peace Process their best attempt, with no positive outcome.
